Jack Russell Terrier Races – Monday, October 17th - Watch feisty and unpredictable little dogs negotiate small hurdles as they follow a lure to the finish line.

Parking is free. General Admission tickets for the first nine days of the show – October 13 – 21 - are \$10 for regular adult admission and \$5 for students and seniors (over 65). Children under 6 are free in General Admission seats.

On Grand Prix Saturday, October 22nd, adult general admission seats are \$20 and \$10 for students and seniors. Reserved Seats for the evening session, which also allows all day admission, are available at
